

INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FOR THE APPLICATION OF CREATIVE TECHNOLOGIES FOR SCHOOLCHILDREN - "VENTSPILS IT CHALLENGE".

Students from Latvia, Estonia and Lithuania participated in it. The Lieporiai gymnasium students participated in the competition in Venspils (Latvia) for 3 days, which included international teams. The pupils participated in various events, established new contacts and got acquainted with the



city of Venspils. The competition was attended by teams of three age groups: B (grades 4 to 6), C (grades 7-9) and D (grades 10-12). Each team consisted of three students and one teacher or counselor. Students of Lieporiai gymnasium: Lukas Skėrys, Rytis Strankauskas, Rokas Šimulis. Students are taught by the computer science teacher Jovita Navickienė. The purpose of the competition was to find a problem in their place of residence (in a village, in the county, in the city), to create a short videogame with the problem and the possible layout of its solution and to publish it on the site on YouTube.
