Ravenna, 18-24/09/2017

## REPORT

The second Learning/Teaching/Training Activity C2 was held in Ravenna from 18th to 24th September 2017, as required by the project and the timetable.

All the activities have been carried out according to the programme we had planned.

### *Monday, 18<sup>th</sup> September 2017*

The delegations arrived in Ravenna in different ways and times. The Italian teachers, host students and families took care of them and after a short meeting to present the activities everyone reached home.

### *Tuesday, 19<sup>th</sup> September 2017*

At 08:15 all guest students and teachers arrived at school.

From 08:30 to 09:30 we had the presentations of the Italian national educational system, of the school and of Ravenna and its territory.

From 09:30 to 10:30, all guest students visited the school and joined classes according to the daily school timetable.

From 10:15 to 11:00, we had a coffee break with food offered by students and families.

From 11:00 to 12:30,

- all guest students were split into smaller groups and then they were integrated in classes, where workshops related to inclusion were carried out.
- The teachers had their second official meeting, where they discussed all the aspects of the project.

In the afternoon,

at 14:30, the guided tour started, held by the Italian students as guides. The first part of the 7 Unesco World Heritage Monuments was visited.

### *Wednesday, 20<sup>th</sup> September 2017*

From 08:15 to 11:30, the second part of the guided tour of the 7 Unesco World Heritage Monuments was held by the Italian students.

From 11:30 to 13:00, a workshop of traditional mosaics was realized at the TAMO Museum and students and teachers learnt to realize a mosaic with small tesserae in different colours.

Afternoon.

At 13:30 the whole group went to Marina di Ravenna to meet the NGO Marinando, who works with people with mental and health disabilities helping them to sail and take confidence with the sea life.

At 16:30 all the delegations were received at the Villaggio del Fanciullo, an NGO who works with different types of disadvantaged people: minors without parents, drug addicted, ex-prisoners.

At 17:00 in the same place the cooking class took place: students and teachers discovered the secrets of a perfect Italian pizza under the direction of a winner of the Pizza World Championship. Finally, they can eat not only their handmade pizza but a true professional pizza in the same place.

#### *Thursday, 21<sup>st</sup> September 2017*

All the day was dedicated to visit Venice.

Venice is an extraordinary city built over water and walking in the narrow streets, looking at the monuments, hearing the presentations made by the Italian students, all the group, students and teachers could reflect on the changing conditions of history and power and how it's easy to be a king one day and a poor foreigner the day after. So we have to work to guarantee to everyone a decent condition of life, wherever he/she comes from.

#### *Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2017*

At 8:15 we had the project activity at school. The core of this activity was the follow-up of a long-term activity made in the project eTwinning platform, the Twin Space, was to investigate about:

1. The best practices in our towns about inclusion made by NGOs and local groups
2. How can the schools introduce some of these activities in the curriculum

After a 3 months' work on Twin Space the meeting was the place where to share best practices, discuss about them and find the way to introduce good practice to solve problems in formal education.

At the end of the activity a manifesto was written with some cardinal points and it's attached here.

At 10:30 we had the meeting with Ouidad Bakkali, the Counsellor for Human Rights in the Town Hall in Ravenna. During the meeting, many students participated and gave their appreciated contribution. It was clear that we cannot build a society if we build walls or borders. Ouidad Bakkali, young girl, coming from a Muslim Moroccan family and Counsellor in the Town Council was a perfect witness of this integration we need.

At 12:00 we had a lecture at the University of Ravenna. Prof. Annalisa Furia, Lecturer in History of Political Thought at the University, held a lecture about Who is a foreigner. History of inclusion, examining some typical biases we had when we talk about a foreigner, from the ancient Greece to the modern liquid societies. After a break offered by the school, the whole group visited the two laboratories of the University, the first one dedicated to diagnosing and restoring ancient paintings and the second one, the FrameLab, a multi-award winner laboratory used to develop researches on cultural heritage using digital tools

In the evening: the farewell dinner in a typical local restaurant.

#### *Saturday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2017*

At 09:00 Scavenger hunt in the historical city centre organized and held by the students.

At 11:00 we had a scheduled meeting with an NGO but being it the organizer of the night event we leave free time to students and teachers to enjoy the exhibition of gardens in town.

At 21:00 in the renewed Darsena district, we had the final event organized by the last NGO we met: Casa delle culture (joint with Città Meticcica and Mercato Equo e Solidale), who is an NGO who works with migrants to give them first aid, language courses, opportunities, culture and chances to integrate like during the Festival of Cultures when all the groups are invited to perform a spectacle according to their traditions.

The final event was a concert held by the JackGuitar Band and the Refugees Choir. This choir is exclusively composed of refugees hosted in the Italian camps not far from Ravenna.

The music was nice and involving and students and teachers danced following the reggae rhythm.
