Ravenna, 21-25/11/2016

REPORT

The first TPM was held in Ravenna from 21st to 25th November 2016, as required by the project and the timetable. Attached you can find the programme, the invitations, and the certificates.
After each activity, you can see the related priority.

All the planned activities have been regularly held.

21st November 2016

All teachers were picked up upon arrival at the central railway station in Ravenna. During this first informal meeting, they were introduced to the city and its surroundings and they were taken to the hotel. (*Inclusion*)

22nd November 2016

At 08:30 all teachers were picked up at the hotel and taken to school.

From 08:45 to 10:45 we had the presentations, in this order:

Liceo Classico Ravenna (students and staff) presented the Italian Education System and, then, their school. (*ICT and Life Skills*)

The partner teachers presented their country and their school.

Then there was a guided tour of the school.

At 10:30 we had a coffee break with food offered by students and staff.

(*Inclusion, Creativity and Life Skills*)

At 11:00 we had the first formal meeting about the project.

All the stated conclusions are at the end of this report.

After a lunch offered by the school, at 14:45 the guided tour of the Unesco monuments started.

With the skilled guide of the students (*Non-formal learning, Creativity, Life Skills, Entrepreneurship*) we visited 5 out of 7 Unesco World Heritage monuments in Ravenna.

At 17:15 all the activities finished.

23rd November 2016

At 09:00 the International Conference "New competencies for a new world" started with greetings by the local authorities.

From 09:30 to 11:00 the Erasmus+ teachers gave their speeches about:
Non formal learning at GroeneWelle (Harrie Meijer);
Competencies for the 21st century (Wim Roosken);
The Six Thinking Hats (Sigita Šernaitė);
Theatre between classic studies and new technologies (Kyriaki Katsirou).
Then the four Italian speakers gave a speech about *ICT in teaching, Robotics, Project Based Learning* and *ETwinning*.
In the afternoon, after the conference, the Erasmus+ group visited one of the most awarded wine cellars in the area (Fattoria Paradiso) to discover how traditional work can join new ways of communication and high technology. (*Life Skills, Entrepreneurship*)
At 18:15 all the activities finished.

24th November 2016

We went on a full-day trip to Ferrara.

During the journey, we had one more meeting about the project. All the conclusions are at the end of this report.

At 10:40 we went on a guided visit of the International Exhibition “Orlando Furioso 500 years” (*Non-formal learning, Creativity, Life Skills, Entrepreneurship*)

At 13:00 we had lunch in the oldest tavern in the world to discover traditional food and history. (*Non-formal learning, Creativity, Life Skills*)

In the afternoon, in the heart of the medieval city, we visited the Jewish ghetto, an area which preserves/contains the memories of the centuries-old Jewish Community of Ferrara and where the same community was from 1627 to 1861 (*Inclusion, Universal Democracy*)

At 17:30 the first part of activities was over.

At 20:30 We had the farewell dinner with a fish menu, to discover the old recipes from the poor villages of fishermen on the Adriatic Sea. (*Non-formal learning, Inclusion*)

25th November 2016

The certificates were handed out. Then the partners greeted each other and left for their countries.
